1-Day Ride on August 14th
2nd CRC to New City Kids: Grand Rapids and back!

Information Sheet

How much do I have to raise?

\$25 registration fee - this covers the cost of your ride shirt and additional expenses. It also allows for the money fundraised to go 100% towards breaking the cycle of poverty for urban youth.

\$1000 minimum fundraising goal - Each rider is asked to raise a minimum of \$1000 to support youth in Grand Rapids and Detroit.

What about rest stops?

There will be an aid station about every 10 miles where there will be snacks, drinks, and bathrooms.

Do I need to own a nice bike?

Nope! And if you need a bike or need help fixing one up, we can point you in the right direction.

Will there be hills?

There will be mild-moderate climbing. Some rolling hills in the country, but mostly flat beautiful terrain.

Will it be fun?

Oh yeah! The ride is a blast. The route is beautiful, the people are amazing and the food is incredible!

Do I need to be an expert cyclist?

Nope! You just need to be able to complete the route you signed up for. The 35 mile ride should be feasible for those who are less experienced.

What does the route look like?

35 mile ride: This route starts at New City Kids: Grand Rapids and ends at 2nd CRC.

70 mile ride: This route starts and ends at 2nd CRC with a halfway point at New City Kids: Grand Rapids.

These routes allow everyone to get a chance to spend time at the water, see the beautiful countryside of Michigan, and visit the place you are raising money for!

What is the itinerary for the day?

7:00am - Registration opens at Grand Haven

8:00am - 70 mile start from Grand Haven

9:30am - Registration opens at New City Kids: Grand Rapids

10:30am - 35 mile start from New City Kids: Grand Rapids

11:30am - All riders have passed through New City Kids: Grand Rapids

1:30pm - Food and Fun in Grand Haven

2:00pm - Awards/recognition
